## **About the Irene Schultze Scholarship**

The Irene Schultze Memorial Scholarship was created to assist high school seniors who want to pursue a postsecondary degree.

The scholarship is named after Irene Schultze by her three children, Diane, Eric, and Jackie. This scholarship is a tribute to her commitment to education.

## **Introduction**

The Irene Schultze Memorial Scholarship is administered by the EVSC Foundation, Inc. on behalf of her family who established the scholarship to provide opportunities for advanced education for Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation (EVSC) students at Central High School.

This scholarship is intended to support the education of students who have the motivation, determination, and talent to attend college but lack the financial resources to do so.

The selection process of the recipient will be by a committee with representatives from EVSC Foundation and EVSC, and any others as deemed necessary. Awards are based on a competitive process which may consider academic achievement, extracurricular activities, personal aspirations, and educational goals.

## **Eligibility**

Applicants must:

- Be a graduating high school senior from Central High School within the EVSC.
- Have a minimum cumulative high school grade point average of 2.5 or

higher on a 4.0 scale (or an equivalent).

- Hold a citizenship rating or its equivalent.
- Plan to enroll full-time\*\* at an accredited Indiana public college, university, or community college, no later than the fall semester of 2010.
- Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA on 4.0, barring compelling non-academic reasons, while attending the selected college or university.

*\*\*Full-time study is defined as full-time enrollment for the entire academic year.*

## **Award Criteria**

Selection of recipients will be based on solid academic performance and participation within student organizations.

Financial need is a consideration.

Awards are for undergraduate study only and are awarded without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, age, gender or disability.

### **Submitting the application packet:**

Carefully review your application before submission. All pages must be submitted in a manila envelope in the following order:

1. Completed Application Form
2. Completed Essay Response
3. Official grade transcript (most recent)
4. Copy of applicant's Student Aid Report (SAR)

Once the application is submitted, no further additions or changes may be made. The application must be submitted to the EVSC Foundation, Inc at One SE 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Evansville, IN 47708 by April 30, 2010.

Applicants are solely responsible for submitting all information necessary to the application process. EVSC Foundation reserves the right not to process applications found to be incomplete as of the application deadline. All information submitted is considered confidential and is reviewed only by scholarship committee.

### **Award Amount**

The scholarship amount is \$1,000 per semester for four years.

The scholarship recipient and his or her counselor will be notified by mail in May.

### **Payment of Scholarships**

The Scholarship check will be made payable to the recipient's college or university and mailed to the college or university upon receipt of the necessary paperwork that must be filed with the EVSC Foundation. This paperwork will be provided to the recipient at the Class Day assembly when the scholarship is announced.

### **To the Applicant**

By completing the information required in this application, you will demonstrate your eligibility to receive funds contributed by the Irene Schultze Memorial Scholarship and the EVSC Foundation.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as thoroughly as possible. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by the scholarship committee.
